At TIS, we continuously endeavor to simulate an environment that goes beyond conventional academic learning. One such initiative is the integration of Skill Education in classes VI to VIII through Skill Club activities. These activities are designed to encourage students to think, evaluate and apply what they have learned, thus gaining real-life skills.

We also incorporate Performing and Visual Arts in the form of Art Pursuit activities that are designed to enable students to explore and know their abilities.

Each student is required to opt for *ONE ART PURSUIT* and *ONE SKILL CLUB* activity. She/he will continue with the same Art Pursuit till grade VIII. However, the Skill Club activity is for the duration of one session i.e. 2024-25 only. The allotment of the activities will be done on the basis of her/his choice and availability of seats for that particular activity. In case any activity is oversubscribed, then the allotment will be done through draw of lots and then options looked at. The details are given below:

#### 1. Astronomy Club-

Astronomy & Space Science are the most effective ways to inculcate a scientific temper. We are offering the Astronomy Club in collaboration with SPACE INDIA, a pioneer organization with a legacy of 23 years in

developing Astronomy, Space Science and STEM education at grassroots levels and beyond. This year we are introducing a revised curriculum with new modules, upgraded learning tools and astronomy resource kit to practice more hands-on learning.

The program fee is inclusive of a kit having activity materials, a 50 mm Refractor telescope and an overnight visit to Jim Corbett.

Physical classes will be conducted on the school campus, three consecutive working days a month, for one hour per day, starting from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Follow-up online sessions will be scheduled every 15 days, during holidays and interim months (June, September, October and January).

To ensure the dedication and commitment of our QUIZZADOR members, a nominal fee of ₹500/- per month will be charged. This fee should be paid in cash to the Quiz Club In-charge, Ms. Niela Hariharan, at the beginning of each month.
