The School in association with SPACE is organizing an overnight trip for dark sky observation, for astronomy club members to Astroport, near Sariska National Park on Thursday, 11 April 2024. There are no fees for this event.

Astroport is India's first Astronomy theme-based resort which has been developed to provide a great sky viewing and research experience to the budding astronomers in a serene and lush environment, located near the Tiger reserve. The site is placed well away from the pollution of light, air and sound.

The camp highlights include various hands-on experiences like sky reading through Sky Map, planets identification in real sky in real time, motion of the stars, observing constellations, rotation and revolution concept, telescope and its handling

The program details are as follows:

- Observation Venue : Astroport, SPACE Research Facility Center, Tehla, Sariska, Alwar (Rajasthan),
- Duration : Overnight (11&12 April 2024)
- Reporting time at School: 9:00 a.m. at Gate No. 1
- Departure from School : 9:30 a.m.
- Arrival at School : 1:30 p.m. on Friday, 12 April 2024

Please take a note of the following:

- Parents are requested to drop & collect their wards from the school premises as per schedule.
- Please ensure that your ward carries a torch with red cellophane sheet, a set of extra batteries, notepad, pen, pencil, sharpener, water bottles, Planisphere and 50 mm telescope.
- The temperature at the observation site is a few degrees colder than the city. A jacket, full pants and comfortable shoes are advised.
- The children will be provided dinner & morning breakfast at the venue.
- Kindly provide snacks/lunch to students for transit. There will also be a halt during the journey and students may avail eatables at their own expense.
- The observation is weather (fog & cloud) dependent & subject to change.
- Students will be responsible for any electronic gadget, camera etc that they carry with them.
