Dear Parent,
Each student in middle school (classes $\mathrm{VI}-\mathrm{VIII})$ is required to study three languages. The choice of the third language has to be made in class VI .

- English is the first language for all students.
- INDIAN nationals will study Hindi compulsorily as the second language. Nationals of other countries will be exempted from studying Hindi.
- However, all students have to study a third language.
- The school offers a choice between French/ Sanskrit/ Spanish as the third language. All students will have to opt for ONE of the three languages.
- They have to be certain of their choice as they will have to study the same language till class VIII and no change at a later date or class will be possible.
- It is mandatory to pass in the third language Final Examination in order to be eligible for promotion to the next class.

To be eligible to study French or Spanish in the middle school, the student has to score a minimum of B1 in each area of English in the two terms of the current session of class V. A language ability assessment may also be conducted at the end of the term to determine the student's eligibility for the foreign languages. The final decision, however, will rest with the English teacher and the Principal.
