

## 2. Analytical Essay Writing

## Understand the objective of an analytical essay.

An analytical essay means you will present some type of argument or claim, about what you are analyzing. Most often you will have to analyze another piece of writing or a film, but you could also be asked to analyze an issue or an idea. To do this, you must break the topic down into parts and provide evidence, either from the text/film or from your research, that supports your claim.

You can choose a subject for your essay on your own, there are some important points to follow. There are many analytical paragraph topics for your future essay, but be careful and avoid dulling and unexciting ones. For this reason, it's important to take time to realize which subject you want to investigate and think twice before making a final decision.
