Section A

Turn page Adventures

Create an innovative and engaging e-flip book using any one app: Flipbook Maker, Canva, e-Book Creator, etc. The flip book should contain at least 8-10 pages.

Front Cover

- ✤ Design a vibrant cover featuring illustrations of iconic Manipur and enigmatic Nagaland.
- ✤ Give an interesting title, for instance:

"Echoes of the East: Flip book stories from Manipur to Nagaland"

- Begin by presenting an interactive map highlighting the geographical features / landforms of Manipur and Nagaland. You may follow with a brief introduction to the rich culture and traditions of Nagaland and Manipur- tribes, festivals, dance forms, and musical instruments.
- Design the first few pages highlighting the cultural significance of monuments and landmarks in communities of Nagaland and Manipur. Incorporate fascinating anecdotes of the erstwhile Kings and Rulers of Nagaland or Manipur dynasties to enrich the narrative. Create or find illustrations or graphics that complement the content and enhance the visual appeal of your pages.

Unity Unfolded: Harmony in Pages

- Research the diverse designs, including those inspired by tribal motifs, incorporated into Manipuri textiles. Observe the intricate patterns within these designs to gain insight into the rich cultural heritage of Manipur. Create two bookmarks inspired by these designs and the patterns created by you using weaving techniques with paper strips, ribbons, or threads of different colours. Explain the pattern created by you in your own words and include the rules of the patterns as well.
- Your mother's wardrobe can be an interesting collection of fabrics. Can you identify some intriguing patterns in her outfits? Also, determine the name of each pattern and the state it originates from. Once you've gathered this information, tabulate this information.
- Creativity knows no boundaries! How creatively can you utilize everyday materials like coins, matchsticks, or any easily available resources to craft your own number or shape patterns? Once you've gathered your materials, establish a rule for creating your patterns.

StoryCraft Puppets: Weaving Wonder

Create DIY stick puppets of dolls at your home into indigenous Manipur and Nagaland dolls. Use them as puppets and record a video (not more than 3 minutes). In the video, highlight their cultural significance, traditional attire, and narrate a story that illuminate the distinctive features of Manipuri and Naga cultures.. Paste the link of the story using Google Drive in the e-Flip Book.

Back cover

- To add a touch of authenticity and connection, incorporate your own photo while you're engaged in creating a popular craft work of Manipur/Nagaland like bamboo craft, paper weaving, etc. Create a self-illustration for the back cover of the book about these regions.
- Make an interesting video of the above activity and paste the link URL on the back cover.
- Include a QR code/website link where you can access additional resources and activities related to the rich heritage of Manipur and Nagaland.

SECTION B

Culinary Conversations

Explore the traditional herbal remedies and culinary uses of plants found in Manipur and Nagaland. Then create a herbal remedies cookbook using Canva featuring recipes using locally available plant ingredients. It may include any two recipes based on herbal teas/ medicinal concoctions /culinary dishes that incorporate the native plants of Manipur and Nagaland.

Recipe Presentation and Design:

- Design a visually appealing layout for your herbal cookbook in a scrapbook.
- Write a recipe of your choice, along with information about the health benefits of the ingredients.
- Include illustrations or photographs of the herbal ingredients used in your recipe. Label each ingredient with its name and provide a brief description or fun fact/trivia.
- Use adjectives to evoke the aroma, taste, and texture of the ingredients and explore vocabulary related to cooking, herbs, and culinary traditions.
- Create a list of key culinary terms such as sauté, simmer, infusion, and garnish and their usage in everyday life.

Fraction Fun with Recipes:

- Analyze the ingredient quantities in your recipes and identify fractions used in measurements. For example, 1/2 teaspoon of cinnamon, 3/4 cup of water, etc.
- Create and solve at least 4 fraction statement questions based on the ingredient measurements in your recipes. For example, if a recipe requires 1/4 cup of chopped mint leaves and you only have 1/8 cup, how much more do you need?

- ✤ Choose one herbal ingredient commonly used in Manipur/Nagaland recipes.
- Research on the scientific properties and health benefits of the chosen herb.
- Create an e-flyer summarizing your findings and explaining how the herb contributes to the health and well-being of individuals.
