Here are some folktales and authors from the North Eastern states of India that you might find interesting:


- The Tale of Kharswan (Meghalaya):


Read any one book and be prepared for discussion based on any one of the following activities when school reopens.

PSYCHOLOGY

"Mental Health Conditions in North-East India"

Mental health is a state of mental well-being that enables people to cope with the stresses of life, realize their abilities, learn well and work well, and contribute to their community. It is an integral component of health and well-being that underpins our individual and collective abilities to make decisions, build relationships and shape the world we live in. Mental health is a basic human right. And it is crucial to personal, community and socio-economic development.

Mental health is more than the absence of mental disorders. It exists on a complex continuum, which is experienced differently from one person to the next, with varying degrees of difficulty and distress and potentially very different social and clinical outcomes.

Mental health conditions include mental disorders and psychosocial disabilities as well as other mental states associated with significant distress, impairment in functioning, or risk of self-harm. People with

mental health conditions are more likely to experience lower levels of mental well-being, but this is not always or necessarily the case.

With reference to the above topic, design two web pages on Mental Health in **Assam & Meghalaya** respectively. Your content should cater to the following points:

- 1. Psychological disorders common in that region and its comorbidity with Depression, Anxiety and Substance Abuse Disorders.
- 2. Possible causes of rising mental health issues.
- 3. Map the mental health care facilities and resources in that region.
- 4. Central and State Government initiatives for preventive awareness about one's well-being taken in the last 5 years in terms of healthcare and education.
- 5. Do a comparative analysis of prevalence of mental health conditions in Delhi with mental health conditions in Assam & Meghalaya

Task 2: (For Computer Science Students)Agroforestry Simulation Game: A multiplayer simulation game where players manage virtual farms and forests in Northeast India, making decisions related to crop selection, soil conservation, and agroforestry practices. Players could compete or collaborate to maximize their yields, minimize environmental impact, and achieve sustainable development goals.

Task 3: The dama and flute are traditional musical instruments used by various tribes in Northeast India, including the Garo tribe in Meghalaya. Design or procure Dama and Flute and prepare a 2 min musical presentation.

Task 4: Art Installation showcasing Solar and Lunar Eclipse or musical instruments.
