Dear Parent,

As per CBSE guidelines, students of Classes VI to VIII are required to study three languages.

- English is the first language and is compulsory for all students.
- Hindi is the second language and is compulsory for Indian nationals. Students who are nationals of other countries are exempted from studying Hindi.
- The third language offered by the school includes Spanish, French, and Sanskrit. All students are required to opt for any one of these languages.

Parents and students are requested to make this choice carefully, as the selected third language will be studied continuously for the next three years (Classes VI to VIII). No change will be permitted at a later stage or in any subsequent class. Students who qualify for Spanish or French will also have the opportunity to continue studying the language up to Class X.

Please note that students will be eligible to opt for Spanish or French based on their performance in English in Class V. Students securing a minimum grade of B1 in each skill area of English will be eligible for these languages.

You are requested to indicate your order of preference for the third language in the Subject Detail Slip provided below and submit the duly filled slip to the Class Teacher by Friday, 6 February 2026. While making your selection, please keep your ward's proficiency and performance in English in mind.
