We are pleased to inform you that your ward has been selected to participate in the **2026 Shanghai International Youth Science & Technology Innovation Camp and "Science & Technology Stars of Tomorrow" Invitational Tournament**, scheduled to be held from Sunday, 26 July 2026 in Shanghai. The programme will continue until 31 July 2026, followed by a two-day trip to Beijing on Saturday, 01 August 2026 and Sunday, 02 August 2026.

This prestigious international programme will provide students with a valuable platform to explore science and technology, engage in collaborative learning, interact with young innovators from across the world, and gain meaningful exposure to global practices in Science, Innovation, and Research.

The proposed travel itinerary and cost details are shared below.

Proposed Travel Itinerary

Date / Day	Programme Details
Saturday, 25 July 2026	Departure from Delhi to Shanghai by China Eastern Airlines, flight MU-564.
Sunday, 26 July 2026	Arrival in Shanghai. Participation in the 2026 SIYSTI Camp as per the organisers' schedule.
Monday, 27 July – Friday 31 July 2026	Participation in camp activities, competitions, innovation sessions, student interactions, and related educational engagements in Shanghai.
Saturday, 1 August 2026	Travel from Shanghai to Beijing by flight MU-5151. On arrival in Beijing, visit Tian'anmen Square and the Forbidden City, followed by hotel check-in after dinner.
Sunday 2 August 2026	Beijing sightseeing: visit to Jade Factory, Great Wall at Juyong Pass, photo stop at Beijing Olympic Park, outside view of Bird's Nest and Water Cube, Temple of Heaven, and Tea House visit.
Monday, 3 August 2026	Early morning checkout and transfer to Beijing Airport. Return flight to Delhi via Shanghai by China Eastern Airlines, flight MU-5102.

The total cost of the programme is **₹1,60,000/- (One lakh sixty thousand) per participant**, inclusive of travel, accommodation, meals as per the itinerary, sightseeing, insurance, GST, TCS, visa charges, and other related expenses. Payment is to be made by cheque in favour of AMATRA TRAVEL AND LEISURE PRIVATE LIMITED. Parents are requested to submit the duly filled consent form along with the programme fee to Ms. Vandana Sen Gupta by Tuesday, 19 May 2026.
